## **Aquatic Safety Inspector Recertification**

#### If it's foreseeable, it's preventable

Faced with the potential for multi-million-dollar lawsuits, pool owners and operators are increasingly aware of the benefits of being proactive in assessing and managing risk in the aquatic environment. The Lifesaving Society believes that many incidents are foreseeable and therefore preventable.

#### Who should attend the Aquatic Safety Inspector Recertification course?

Currently certified Lifesaving Society Aquatic Safety Inspectors who wish to recertify should attend this course. Updated checklists will be provided and a comprehensive review will be done of the new Regulations effecting public pools.

Prerequisite: Lifesaving Society Aquatic Safety Inspector certifications.

- The legislation and operating practices that dictate the current operating standards of aquatic facilities in Ontario.
- > Architectural plan review process and checklist review.
- > A review of the Lifesaving Society new Inspection checklists

### **SEE Auditor (Supervision Evaluation and Enhancement)**

#### Who should attend the one-day course?

Professionals in aquatic programming, facility management, swimming pool operations and recreation who want the knowledge and practical experience that will enable them to conduct safety audits of aquatic operations within a community, through a process established by the Lifesaving Society. SEE Auditors will be a part of the Lifesaving Society team who conduct comprehensive safety audits of lifeguarding and instructing performance within communities across Canada. They may also provide this service on their own.

**Course pre-requisites**: NLS with at least 100 hours of experience lifeguarding or AST OR AMT or NLS Examiner.

- How to conduct SEE audits of aquatic operations- using advanced checklists supplied by the Lifesaving Society
