RE: Lifesaving Sport Sanctioning Package

Ontario

Thank you for your interest in hosting a Lifesaving Sport opportunity for Athletes, Coaches and Officials.

The Lifesaving Society Ontario sanctions regional and provincial competitions to ensure a safe operational plan.

The following outlines:

- The *benefits* to sanctioning
- The *criteria* for sanctioning
- The *review* processes
- The *follow-up* required post-competition
- Resources for planning

### **Benefits:**

- 1. <u>Liability Insurance</u> a sanctioned competition provides Lifesaving Society insurance to officials, and volunteers supervised by a Lifesaving Society certified Referee and/or Manager. A Liability Certificate can be requested as part of the application.
- 2. <u>Promotions</u> all sanctioned events will be added to the Lifesaving Sport calendar on the website. Calls for volunteers and notification to clubs/affiliates will be distributed (if requested in application). Only those events sanctioned may carry the Lifesaving Society logos and be promoted as "sanctioned."
- 3. <u>Qualifying Experience</u> hours spent volunteering at a sanctioned competition qualify for experience hours within leadership programs.
- 4. <u>Policies and procedures</u> a sanctioned competition provides the organizers with access to score sheets and rule books produced by the Lifesaving Society and the International Life Saving Federation.
- 5. <u>Key Officials</u> a sanctioned competition ensures that the personnel organizing and running the competition have been trained and certified by the Lifesaving Society.

#### Criteria:

- 1. <u>Lifesaving Society Affiliate</u>. Sanctioned competitions must be hosted by a Lifesaving Society Affiliate/Club.
- 2. <u>Certified Meet Manager.</u> The event must be organized by a currently certified Lifesaving Society Meet Manager.
  - a. To organize and run the event in compliance with Lifesaving Society standards, policies, procedures.
  - b. To ensure safety in planning.
- 3. <u>Certified Key Chief Referee.</u> The event must be overseen by a current certified Lifesaving Society Chief Referee.
  - a. To be on-site during the event to ensure the safety of participants.
  - b. To ensure the event is run following the sanctioning body's policies, procedures and standards.

## Note: the Meet Manager and Meet Referee can be the same person.

- 4. <u>Facility Specifications</u>. The facility must meet the specifications as outlined in the current Ontario Competition Manual.
- 5. <u>Eligibility</u>. Eligibility can be determined by the Host.
- 6. <u>Re-submission</u>. Changes to the facility(ies) or Chief Referee or Meet Manager after the competition has been sanctioned will require a resubmission for re-evaluation and sanctioning.
- 7. <u>Events.</u> Sanctioned events must adhere to current competition manual rules. Non-sanctioned events must be identified as such in the Competition Package.

#### **Review:**

- 1. Upon receipt of the application form, the Lifesaving Society will review the submission. A draft copy of the Host Competition package with Schedule of Events must be received with this application.
- 2. The Review Team will follow up on any clarification or missing information.
- 3. The applicant will be notified of approval or decline of approval via email. All declined submissions will include rationale for the determination.
- 4. Approved applicants will be notified via email of the approval.
- 5. Once sanctioned, the event will be added to the competition calendar on the website using the information contained in the application.

# **Post-Competition Follow-Up:**

1. Within two (2) weeks of the competition, submit the Post-Competition Report.
