

Examiner/ Examiner Mentor Points List



This Points List is for EXAMINERS and EXAMINER MENTORS only. Points from this list will recertify an examiner's eligible instructor, coach and examiner awards. Use the Points List for the highest award you hold.

In order to recertify you must earn a total of 4 points – with a minimum of 2 points from the **Mandatory Category**. Other points can be earned from either the Open or Mandatory Category. Unless otherwise marked, eligible items may be used more than once to recertify. Example: Examining two separate Bronze Medallion courses equals 4 points.

Use this list as a reference when recertifying online. List each item used to recertify on your [Leadership Recertification Form](#).

Mandatory – 2 points

- Examine Bronze Medallion (original or recert)
- Examine Bronze Cross (original or recert)
- Examine Intermediate First Aid with CPR-C & AED course (original or recert)
- Examine National Lifeguard course - any option
- Examine National Lifeguard recert - any option
- Mentor an Apprentice on an Exam
- Present a session at the Society's request

Mandatory – 3 points

- Appointment as Examiner Mentor (1st time)
- Pass Trainer Course

Mandatory – 4 points

- Pass Instructor Recertification Course

Note: Points earned by taking, teaching or examining an Emergency or Standard First Aid course during an instructor's/examiner's recertification period can be used to recertify awards.
