This Points List is for TRAINERS only. Points from this list will recertify a trainer's eligible instructor, coach, examiner and trainer awards. Use the Points List for the highest award you hold.

In order to recertify you must earn a total of 4 points – with a minimum of 2 points from the **Mandatory Category**. Other points can be earned from either the Open or Mandatory Category. Unless otherwise marked, items may be used more than once to recertify. Example: Teaching two separate First Aid Instructor courses equals 4 points.
